Responsibilities

- Uses leadership and organizational abilities to plan, oversee, supervise, and improve all aspects of the basketball program
- Must be able to communicate with children and parents in a positive and professional manner
- Set vision, goals, and standards for the program
- Act in a professional manner at all times
- Attend and arrive at all practices, games, and other events in a timely manner
- Conduct practices and prepare for competition
- Follow and enforce the rules and regulations of CHS and the MIAA
- Submit a written inventory at the beginning and end of the season

- Collect ALL equipment and uniforms at the end of the season.
- Verify student eligibility prior to first practice with the Athletic Director/Dean of Culture
- Submit a final roster to Athletic Director prior to the first contest
- Complete all required coaching documents before the first contest and submit them to Athletic Director
- Assist students with the college recruiting process
- Assist with the formation of the regular season schedule
- Complete all required coaching education courses and First Aid/CPR training
- Attend all coaches' meetings scheduled by the CCL and/or Athletic Director
- Travel with the team on the bus to and from all competitions
- Must have a valid Driver's license and a good driving record
- Must be willing to drive the 15-passenger team van to and from athletic events
- Uphold the high standards of Cathedral High School at all times
